2024 Career Outcomes Rate

Career Outcomes Rate:

The percent of completers who report “employed” plus graduates who report “education” within 6 months following graduation.

Knowledge Rate:

The percent of graduates for which the institution has reasonable and verifiable information regarding graduates’ post-graduation plans. The knowledge rate includes those graduates who indicate “other plans” not related to employment or education.
